Compendium of Resources

This document provides a compendium of resources that informed the Institute for Agriculture, Forestry and the Environment (IAFE) board in delivering on its mandate. The IAFE drew on many diverse experts and stakeholders, from within Alberta and elsewhere, to develop its ideas and refine its thinking. It also drew on a wide range of published and unpublished materials and commissioned a number of background reports, briefing notes and other documents to inform its discussions and provide more in-depth analysis of the many considerations related to the development of a recommended ecosystem services market policy framework for Alberta.

This compendium is composed of 42 documents produced or commissioned by IAFE to inform the IAFE Board. Over 600 resources were acquired from local, national and international sources through literature reviews, and presentations that the IAFE received or gave through March 2008 to March 2010. As this is an emerging field of policy and research, the compendium is intended to provide a baseline of information for those interested in gaining a greater understanding of market-approaches for ecosystems services and as a source of the information that informed the IAFE's recommendations. As such, the compendium constitutes a snapshot in time; however, its format allows for a transition to an externally accessible searchable database for future updates.
